APPROVE REPAIRS FOR WALMART WELL:

The purpose of having a meeting called was to be able to proceed with an emergency repair to the Walmart well on Oak Street. The 30-year-old pump has disintegrated. The cost of the repair will be approximately \$76,242. Approval was needed to go ahead and proceed with the repair because if another well goes down, the city will not have enough water pumping to be sustainable. Councilor Williams asked if any of the other pumps were that old. Legion Drive is the oldest well. It was suggested to go ahead and start saving up in case something happens. On a motion from Councilor Peacock and seconded by Councilor Williams, it was unanimously approved to proceed with the repair.
