DAMAGE TO DIGITAL ANTENNAS

Digital antennas are now being used to read all water meters. Effective February 12, 2024, the City of Eastman will require reimbursement for the replacement of any digital antenna that has been damaged. Each location will be given a reprieve on the first replacement. If there is a need for a second replacement, a fee of \$150 will be charged to the customer's account in order to cover the cost of the replacement.

The council retains the right to adjust this fee as needed to maintain the meter and antenna in working condition.
